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## Message from the Head

I can't believe that I have completed my first year as head of St Paul's. It has been quite challenging at times but I have enjoyed every minute. Children, parents and staff have made me feel very welcome. Thank you for your support and I look forward to seeing you again in the new school year. I hope you have a lovely summer.

There are some changes next year that we would like to make you aware of:

- **Footwear**—please try to buy trainers or shoes that are black for September
- **Birthdays**—as a treat instead of bringing things in for their friends on their birthday, children will be able to wear their own clothes for this day. If they have a birthday in the holidays or on a weekend, they can choose to wear their own clothes on the Friday or Monday.
- **Celebration Assembly**—every Friday, we will have a Celebration Assembly. Children will receive certificates, celebrate their birthdays, receive the class trophy for attendance, uniform check, etc. Parents are invited to attend these assemblies which will start at 9:05 am and last until 9:30am.
- **Residentials**—Children in Year 4 will go to Robinwood for the weekend and children in Year 6 will go to Lledr for the week. Dates of these will be given out in September and parents can start to pay in instalments
- **Attendance**—we now have a clear system for monitoring attendance. This will be sent out to all parents in September.
- Each class will have a Welcome meeting for parents in the first few weeks back so you can get to know what your child should be able to do by the end of the year. Dates are as follows and can also be found on our ParentApp.  
Y6—10th Sept, Y2—11th Sept, Y5—13th Sept, Y4—14th Sept, Y1—17th Sept, Y3—18th Sept. All are from 3:30-4pm
- Year 2 and Year 6 will have their first Parents' Evenings on 18th Sept, from 3:30-7pm.
- **Arts Days**—each half term, the whole school will take place in an Arts Day where children will be have the opportunity to do art, music, drama, DT and dance tasks.
